Scholarship Application Process: To apply for these scholarships you must:

- Be a resident of Anderson County
- Belong to an Anderson County 4-H Club
- Be currently enrolled in 4-H
- Be a member of 4-H for a minimum of 4 years
- Be enrolled in a two-year or four-year college/university or a vocational program.

The application is form-fillable. Complete all sections and use "NA" (not applicable), if needed. The required information must be submitted on separate, one-sided pages with a 1.5" left margin and 1" top and right margins with a minimum font size of 10. If handwritten, it must be legible. Illegible forms will not be considered. Staple in the upper left-hand corner and submit the completed scholarship application packet in the numerical order listed below by **5:00 p.m. on March 21**st to the Frontier Extension District Office, located at 411 S. Oak, in Garnett.

- 1. Include your high school transcript or most recent college semester grades. The transcript can be unofficial and is not required to be in sealed envelope. Home school students must provide appropriate documentation for grades.
- 2. Include 2 letters of recommendation from any non-related person. Choose from the following list: high school teacher, counselor, principal, employer (past or present), extension agent, extension program manager, 4-H leader, or an adult mentor.
- **3.** Submit a one-page, single spaced summary of 4-H significant leadership, community service, participation and recognition, up to and including the **2024-2025** 4-H year. Bullet lists or tables may be used. Begin with the most recent accomplishments. Label the 4-H activities accordingly: L=local; C/D=County/ District; A/R=Area/Regional; S=State; N=National; I= International.
- **4.** Submit a one-page essay, double-spaced, titled "How 4-H Has Impacted Me".
- **5.** Include a one-page, single-spaced summary of non-4-H leadership, citizenship, community service, participation and recognition in your school and community, up to and including the **2024-2025** 4-H year. Begin with the most recent accomplishments.
- **6.** Write a short paragraph about your educational and long-term career goals.

The recipient of the Anderson County 4-H Scholarship and Grant Corley Memorial Scholarship will be presented an oversized check at the Anderson County Fair Parade during the Anderson County Fair. After **September 1**st, the scholarship winner will be expected to pick up their check from the Frontier Extension District Office, located at 411 S. Oak, in Garnett. The Anderson County 4-H Scholarship is a \$1000 scholarship. The Grant Corley Memorial Scholarship is a \$200 scholarship.
