




Developing the Policy

- Requests regarding use began in March 2022.
- Outreach to other state, regional, and national partners.
- Partnering with industry:
 - Kansas State University Salina Aerospace and Technology Campus



Timeline





Key Components

- Authorization is tied to Kansas pesticide business license.
- Only for commercial applications.
- No fee for authorization.
- Businesses and applicators must follow KDA, EPA, and FAA requirements.
- Pilots must hold commercial applicator certification in specified categories/subcategories.

B. Requirements for Commercial Pesticide Applications via Drones or Unmanned Aerial Vehicles

- 1. Commercial pesticide applications via drones or unmanned aerial vehicles shall only be permitted in the following categories and subcategories:
 - a. Category 1: Agricultural Pest Control
 - i. Subcategory 1A: Agricultural Plant Pest Control;
 - ii. Subcategory 1B: Agricultural Animal Pest Control;
 - iii. Subcategory 1C: Wildlife Damage Control; and
 - iv. Subcategory 1D: Stump Treatment.
 - b. Category 2: Forest Pest Control.
 - c. Category 3: Ornamental and Turf Pest Control
 - i. Subcategory 3A: Ornamental Pest Control; and
 - ii. Subcategory 3B: Turf Pest Control.
 - d. Category 5: Aquatic Pest Control.
 - e. Category 6: Right-of-Way Pest Control.



Next Steps - Aerial Category

- HB 2607 was signed by the governor April 18, 2024.
- Regulatory changes are in development.
- Aerial applications will require commercial certification in Category 12
 - Aerial Pest Control.
 - Commercial certification required for all aerial applications.
 - Subcategory certifications will also be required.
